Six-Month Follow-up Incentive Form

The Access to American Indian Recovery (AAIR) program is required by Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration (SAMHSA) to obtain 100% compliance with the Six-Month Follow-up GPRAs. In an effort to meet this requirement the provider agreed as part of their provider application to “cooperate fully with SAMHSA’s data collection and evaluation requirements; and to ensure that all GPRAs (Intake, Discharge, and the Six-Month GPRAs follow-up) are completed accurately and on time. Further providers are notified as part of the application process that failure to complete GPRAs accurately and on time will result in the Provider Organization’s suspension from the AAIR Program.

To facilitate compliance, the California Rural Indian Health Board’s (CRIHB) AAIR administration created the Six-Month Follow-up GPRAs Voucher which funds a \$20 client incentive and a \$100 provider incentive for successful contact and completion. Provider organizations have the responsibility to determine how the client incentive will be distributed. Providers must not enter services associated with this voucher until after the Six-Month Follow-up GPRAs is administered and the client has received the incentive. No client incentive shall be entered into the Voucher Management System (VMS) until the client has received and signed a receipt for the incentive which must be kept in the client’s file. For your convenience an example of a receipt is provided.

In an effort to assist the providers in meeting this mandate AAIR developed a PDF of a \$20 incentive coupon which may be given to the client at the time of intake. Please note that the coupon has a place where the provider notes the dates and time that contact must occur to be eligible. As the client application request significant Health Locator Information, the coupon may make the client more receptive to the provision of the requested information. **Follow-up GPRAs window period: You may contact the client 30 days before and up to 60 days after the six-month anniversary of the client intake date. To comply with SAMHSA and receive compensation the provider must complete these follow-up GPRAs no sooner than 5 months and no later than 8 months after the client’s Intake Date. Do not bill AAIR for any Six-Month Follow-up GPRAs that are not completed within this period.**
