



TRADITIONAL HEALER/SPIRITUAL ADVISOR

The Access to American Indian Recovery (AAIR) program requires that providers of traditional medicine/spirituality must be in good standing with the community and recognized as a traditional healer/spiritual advisor in the community where services are to be provided.

Providers of traditional medicine/spirituality must have a minimum of two (2) years of experience as a recognized traditional healer/spiritual advisor in the community where services are to be provided. To demonstrate a provider’s qualifications, a written letter of good standing and recognition must be signed and submitted to AAIR by a tribal chairperson or by the board of directors of an Indian health organization in the community where services will be provided
