



Indian Health Service California Area User Population Fact Sheet September 2020

California has one of the most diverse populations of American Indians and Alaska Natives (AIAN) in the United States, with 109 federally recognized Tribes and approximately 40 federally non-recognized Tribes seeking recognition. Additionally, there are members of other federally recognized Tribes located outside of California, who reside in California due to various federal policies that targeted AIAN populations and enforced assimilation, such as the Indian Relocation Act of 1956.

California currently has 32 Tribal Health Programs, owned and operated by California Tribes, and 8 Urban Indian Health Programs. The data represented here is of those 32 Tribal Health Programs. Urban Indian Health program data is reported through a separate mechanism and is therefore not included in this Indian Health Service California user population summary.

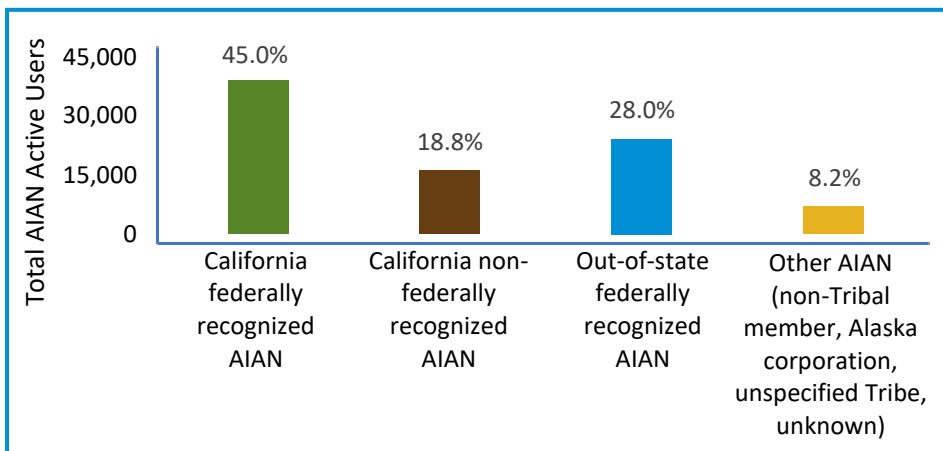
In this fact sheet, 'active users' refer to AIAN patients living in a community or residence assigned to a specific Tribal Health Program. Active users considered in this study are those that utilized a service within the health program at least once between 2016 and 2019. See **Table 1.** and **Figure 1.**

The data from **Table 1.** show that 40.7% (86,077) of Tribal Health Program users are AIAN, while 59.3% (125,628) are non-AIAN.

The data from **Figure 1.** show that within the AIAN category of Tribal Health Program users, a majority 45% (38,761) are from a California AIAN federally recognized Tribe.

The data from **Table 2.** shows active user data for individual Tribal Health Programs. Sycuan Medical Dental Center served the highest percentage of patients from a California federally recognized Tribe, which was 96.7% (87) of their total active patient census. Central Valley Indian Health, Inc. served the largest quantity of patients from a California federally recognized Tribe, which was 53.0% (5,581) of their total active patient census. Chapa-De Indian Health Program, Inc. served 23,516 patients, which was the most active patient census of all the Tribal Health Programs.
